Great October, won 1st in class A, took all awards in all shows, Buckeye Invitational 3rd overall winning class A out of 32 bands 270.3 very pleased with results of this year's show. Will reschedule concert band auditions from 11/10 as it's a Dublin "family night". Last community concert at Dublin Convallarium parking lot, most rewarding experience to date.
- Dublin Scioto – Jazz ensemble has first concert next Tues 7pm, concert also includes fall sport band and chorale choir (32 participants in all). Midstates Championships back in Mason on 11/6, 11/1 recording session in day, end practice at 5pm, then marching band to perform in uniform at the 8th grade band concert, 11/5 930pm OMEA finals, 11/8 is banquet. Orchestra 11/12 7pm, Irish Fiddle Fetish invited to play for the Guernsey Dairy Farm for a company party, paid \$800 to play Irish music for an hour.
